DESCRIPTION

House Bill 1234 amends Title 11 (Cities) to make changes regarding the appointment of city administrators.

This legislation allows city council to appoint a partnership, limited partnership, association or professional corporation as the city administrator pursuant to a professional services agreement. Any employees who directly provide services to the city as part of the appointed partnership, limited partnership, association or professional corporation are prohibited from holding any elected city office.

This legislation provides that only a city administrator who is an individual may also serve as the city chief fiscal officer. Additionally, only a city administrator who is an individual must receive permission from city council to reside outside of the city.

This legislation is scheduled to take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation is not anticipated to have any fiscal impact on the 53 third class cities in the Commonwealth.
