DESCRIPTION

House Bill 1889 amends Chapter 41 (Weights and Measures Generally) of Title 3 (Agriculture) to allow electronic delivery of receipts for light fuel oil deliveries.

The legislation allows for electronic receipts for fuel oil deliveries for meters equipped with the capability of issuing an electronic receipt. It provides that the consumer may be given the option to receive a receipt electronically in lieu of or in addition to a printed receipt. It provides that electronic delivery of a receipt may only be provided if it is agreed to by the consumer and the technology is available. It also prohibits the seller or deliverer from imposing a separate fee for consumers to accept a receipt by any method.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of House Bill 1889 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds as the seller of light fuel oil is responsible for the providing the receipt for sale of the product to the consumer.
