DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 645 amends Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) to provide for a ten-year limitation for acquiring title to vacant land for gardens in cities of the first class.

This legislation allows for the possessor of a vacant lot to acquire the title if the possessor can show they have had possession for not less than 10 years, they have maintained the land as a garden for not less than five years, they have demonstrated the capacity to maintain the space, the land does not exceed an area of one-half acre and the land shall remain a garden or community garden for not less than five years from the date of acquisition. A possessor who attempts to acquire land under this section must commence a quiet title action and provide notice as required under Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) Section 5527.1 (C)(2), (3) and (D).

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 645 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation will have no fiscal impact on the funds of a city of the first class as the title transfer shall have no change on the collection of property taxes owed on the parcel.
