**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 1133 amends the Second Class Township Code to authorize a township board of supervisors to waive, by resolution, a limitation on a tax that supports ambulance, rescue and other emergency services so that more than half of the revenue may be used for compensation of personnel in any calendar year.

The Second Class Township Code currently authorizes townships to use up to half of the revenue generated by this tax for salaries, benefits and other compensation of ambulance, rescue and other emergency services personnel.

This legislation is scheduled to take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This legislation may result in townships reallocating existing tax revenue between expenditure items relating to ambulance, rescue and other emergency services, but it does not provide townships with authority to increase the tax rate above current limits.
