SUBJECT: Co-sponsorship Memo – Transporting Wine (#3)

I will be re-introducing legislation, SB487, to amend the Pennsylvania Liquor Code to permit individuals to transport into the state a small amount of wine for personal consumption. Currently, individuals are permitted to import wine from a foreign country or a United States territory, but if you bring a bottle of wine home from a vacation in a bordering state, you may be arrested. My bill will allow individuals to bring up to 384 ounces (3 gallons) into the state, provided the wine is for personal consumption and not for resale.
