This legislation also assigns penalties according to the amount of toxic waste improperly processed or disposed of. A violator who processes or disposes less than 500 cubic yards of toxic waste would be guilty of a first degree misdemeanor and would be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$2,500 and not more than \$25,000 per day for each violation and up to 5 years in prison. If the amount of illegally processed or disposed toxic waste exceeds 500 cubic yards, the violator would face a third degree felony charge and would be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$5,000 and not more than \$50,000 per violation and a term of imprisonment up to 7 years.
