

RE: Co-sponsorship – Child Protection Zones (#27)

I will be re-introducing legislation, SB724, to establish child protection zones around schools, daycares, and playgrounds. This legislation came out of the original Jessica's Law from last session and would enhance the current protections offered in Pennsylvania's Jessica's Law.

This legislation would prohibit any sexually violent predator who committed a sexual offense against a child from entering a child protection zone. In a city of the first, second, second A or third class or a borough having a population in excess of 3,000, this protection zone will be 1,500 feet. In all other areas, this protection zone will be 3,000 feet.

A sexual offender who enters a child protection zone would face a third degree felony charge.
