## MEMO

**TO:** All House Members

FROM: Representative Ronald Marsico

**RE:** Megan's Law Legislation – Commonwealth vs. Arroyo

As you know, the governor vetoed House Bill 1926, which represented changes made to Megan's Law due to a number of court cases, including <u>Commonwealth vs. Arroyo</u>. When the new session begins, I will introduce legislation to address this case.

The Superior Court held in <u>Commonwealth vs. Arroyo</u> that the criminal penalties for failing to register under Megan's Law did not apply to out-of-state offenders moving into Pennsylvania who had to register for a lifetime in their home states. My legislation will "overturn" <u>Commonwealth vs. Arroyo</u>.

Mr. Arroyo was convicted of committing rape in New York State. He was subject to registration under Megan's Law in New York State, but failed to register with the Pennsylvania State Police upon establishing residence here. When arrested for failure to register, Mr. Arroyo argued that Megan's Law did not apply to him. The Superior Court agreed.
