Co-Sponsorship of Legislation -- Life Insurance Policy Regulations (Former HB2682)

In the near future I will be re-introducing (former HB2682) legislation to address the recent news accounts (see, e.g.

http://www.npr.org/templates/story/story.php?storyId=128799983&ft=1&f=) of life insurance companies that profit from death benefits through use of retained asset accounts. These accounts have been utilized by insurers to pay the proceeds of a life insurance policy, but unfortunately have been – at times – used to the detriment of consumers.

In some instances, consumers have been led to believe that they have immediate access to the account, when in fact they have not had that access. In other instances, the insurance company has earned interest far above what it has paid consumers.

Pennsylvania has no explicit regulatory authority over these practices and my legislation will fill that regulatory hole. Specifically, my legislation will prohibit use of retained asset accounts as the default method for satisfying a life insurance obligation, and will require full disclosure by insurers of those instances where the account is used. The disclosure will include the accounts features, including immediate access to the funds.
