Co-sponsorship Memo - Mandatory Sentence for Carrying

Firearm without a License

In the near future, I will re-introduce Senate Bill 412 from the 2009-2010 Legislative Session.

This legislation would amend Title 18 and require an individual to serve a mandatory minimum one-year sentence for unlawfully carrying firearms without a license on their person or in a vehicle. The amendment would not affect those citizens who maintain firearms in their home or place of business.

SB 412 was co-sponsored by Senators Fontana, Hughes, Kitchen, Washington and Williams.
