SUBJECT: Co-sponsorship of Legislation

In the near future, I plan to reintroduce legislation directing our state's Department of Education to encourage local school districts to develop and implement uniform guidelines relating to food allergy reaction management programs.

The Department of Education (PDE) would also assist local school districts in applying for any available federal grants. Pending federal legislation would provide funds for schools that develop and implement uniform guidelines relating to food allergy reaction management programs.

PDE would also assist local school districts in applying for any available federal grants. Pending federal legislation would provide for schools that develop and implement food allergy reaction management programs. To qualify for these grants, schools must comply with certain uniform guidelines. My bill gives the PDE the responsibility for helping local school districts fully comply with these guidelines.

**This is a reintroduction of Senate Bill 791 from the previous legislative session. Co-sponsors included Senators Kasunic, Tartaglione, Fontana, Hughes and Wonderling.**
