Co-Sponsorship - Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law Amendment

In the near future, I plan to introduce legislation that will amend the Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law to allow any enforcement officer or investigator employed by the Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission or the Pennsylvania Game Commission to be eligible for the benefits provided by the law.

Commonly referred to as Heart and Lung Act coverage, the Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law provides a full range of disability benefits to most state employees who have law enforcement authority under Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes. However, officers from the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission and Pennsylvania Game Commission are currently denied these temporary disability benefits including credit for vacation and retirement during their period of recovery from work-related injuries.

This legislation addresses this inequity by allowing any enforcement officer or investigator of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission or Pennsylvania Game Commission, who has been injured or exposed to certain diseases in the performance of their job duties, to be awarded payment of their salaries, as well as medical and hospital expenses, without the reduction of their usual sick leave period. Any payments made to an enforcement officer or investigator of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission and Pennsylvania Game Commission will be made from the appropriations of their respective employers. It is my hope that this extension of benefits will ensure the safety and health of the many officer and investigators of both commissions.
