SUBJECT:

Legislation to include optometrists in the list of medical providers who may

certify a disability.

In the near future, I intend to introduce legislation amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to allow optometrists to certify a disability for the purpose of issuing a person-with-disability plate or placard.

Under current law, in order to obtain a license plate or placard for a person with a disability, an individual must submit an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT), which must be accompanied by a certified statement from a medical provider who is covered under §1338 (c) (1). Optometrists are not among the list of medical providers who are authorized to issue a certification of disability to PennDOT. Please note that blindness is included in the list of eligible disabilities required to qualify for a plate or placard. It is therefore appropriate to authorize optometrists to make such a designation under Title 75.
