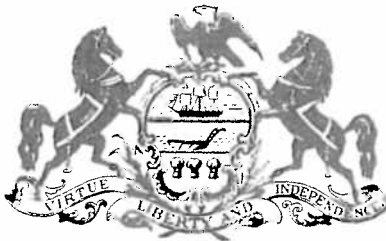

Subject: Increasing permits to participate in alcoholic cider, wine and food expositions – former HB 1860

In the near future, I intend to introduce legislation to amend the Liquor Code. My legislation would allow the holder of a limited winery license to obtain a special permit to participate in alcoholic cider, wine and food expositions off the licensed premises for a total of one hundred (100) days per year. These permits may be used for no more than thirty (30) consecutive days.

Currently, the Liquor Code allows such permits to be granted for a maximum of forty (40) days per calendar year. They may not be used for more than five (5) consecutive days).
