SUBJECT: Memo #4 – Pennsylvania National Guard – Qualifications for Reduced Price Fishing Licenses

In the near future, I plan to reintroduce SB 301 from last session that would reduce from 180 to 60 the number of days that members of the Pennsylvania National Guard must be deployed overseas before qualifying for free or reduced price fishing license.

Act 21 of 2005 allowed members of the Pennsylvania Army National Guard or the Pennsylvania Air National Guard who were deployed overseas for a period of 180 consecutive days or more within the previous 24 months to apply for a fishing license for \$1.

My legislation would amend Title 30 (Fish) and to make members of the Pennsylvania National Guard eligible for free or reduced price licenses if they were deployed overseas for a period of 60 consecutive days or more within the previous 24 months.
