UPDATED - Co-Sponsorship Memo: Phasing out of the PA Inheritance Tax

I plan to reintroduce SB 80 of 2009. The intention of this legislation is to phase out the Pennsylvania Inheritance Tax by 2019. This would be done in a series of phases:

- This legislation would phase out the 4.5% rate that direct descendents (or children) pay by 2014.
- This legislation would also phase out the 12% rate that siblings pay by 2017.
- The 15% rate for other heirs would be phased by 2019.

Pennsylvania is one of the few states that still implement the Inheritance Tax (other states include Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Maryland, Nebraska, New Jersey, and Tennessee).

The Pennsylvania Inheritance Tax is an extremely burdensome tax especially to family farms and small business owners.
