SUBJECT: Co-Sponsorship Memo - Transfer Articulation Language from the Fiscal Code

In the near future, I will be introducing legislation that will repeal the articulation language from the Fiscal Code and transfer it to the Public School Code.

Currently, Article XX-C of Act 14 of 1949, the Public School Code, allows for Transfers of Credits between Institutions of Higher Education for the first 30 credits through agreements between the Community Colleges, the State System of Higher Education institutions and some private higher education institutions who may opt into the program.

The language that has been adopted in the Fiscal Code, Act 176 of 1929, from 2009 and 2010, allows for a second phase of articulation agreements which will include an additional 30 credits for a total of 60 credits or full junior standing. The language also requires the State Related Universities to identify at least 30 credits to be transferred under this Article.
