Subject: *Memo #9: Legislation Reintroduction*

In the near future, I plan to reintroduce the following legislation:

1. Legislation that amends the Tax Reform Code of 1971 to exclude money in a joint bank account from paying inheritance tax if all of the money is derived from one source and that source is the survivor. **This was formerly Senate Bill 705 of last session.**
2. Legislation that would require the State Armory Board to issue rules and regulations for allowing active duty and retired members of the Armed Forces of the United States access only to the fitness facilities within the Armories. This issue was brought to my attention when a constituent of mine, who is retired United States Army Colonel, and was denied access to a fitness facility. **This legislation was Senate Bill 542 of the last session.**
