In the near future, I intend to introduce legislation that would amend Crimes and Offenses (Title 18) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to prohibit the smuggling of human beings.

This legislation is being offered in conjunction with the National Security Begins at Home package that will be introduced in the near future. Specifically, a person who intentionally engages in the smuggling of human beings for profit or other commercial purpose commits a felony of the third degree.
