In the near future, I plan to introduce legislation that would amend Title 30 (Fish & Boat code) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, authorizing the Pennsylvania Attorney General to enter into reciprocal agreements with others states allowing senior citizen fishing licenses issued by the Commonwealth and each state in agreement to be recognized as resident licenses in any state participating in such an agreement.
