Closing Delaware Loophole – Reducing CNI

In the near future, I plan on introducing legislation that enhances tax fairness for all Pennsylvania business. The Delaware Loophole continues to provide an unfair tax advantage for certain corporations doing business in Pennsylvania at the expense of all other businesses.

Its continued exploitation prevents the General Assembly from reducing the state's 9.99% Corporate Net Income (CNI) rate, the second highest in the nation. The legislation proposes closing the loophole by implementing combined reporting to require state tax returns to be filed consistent with federal returns to recoup lost revenue. Those savings would be used to reduce the CNI to 7.5%.

Pennsylvania's economic recovery remains fragile and unsteady. It is critical that we pursue policies that to stimulate the economy, move business forward and create jobs even in the midst of difficult fiscal times.

This legislation is one part of a legislative package called PA Works that is designed to create 28,000 new jobs, leverage over \$2 billion in new private investment and save \$150 million.
