Introduction of Legislation to Make Prevailing Wage Act Local Option for

School Districts

In the near future, I will be introducing legislation to amend the Prevailing Wage Act to make application of the law a "local option" for school districts. My bill would exempt all school districts from coverage of the law, and would permit them to opt into its coverage if they so choose. This legislation has been traditionally introduced by our colleague Chris Ross; Mr. Ross has graciously permitted me to sponsor this legislation this session.

The school districts in my legislative district are facing real financial difficulties (as I'm sure most are around the state), and I believe action on this particular issue is one means of alleviating this stress. Prevailing wage requirements can elevate the costs of school district construction projects and they are anti-competitive.
