Victory Academies

In the near future I will be introducing legislation that will make wholesale changes to the ways Pennsylvania's lowest performing schools are operated. The lowest 5% of schools would become Victory Academies and be reorganized. Victory Academies would require longer school days, Saturday classes, and summer school.
