SUBJECT: Proposed Legislation - The Strike Free Education Act (Prior HB

1369).

In the near future, I will be re-introducing legislation entitled The Strike-Free Education Act.

There are thirty-seven other states that guarantee their school children the legal right to an uninterrupted, strike-free public education. During the 2009-10 school year, Pennsylvania once again maintained its status as the undisputed Teacher Strike Capitol of the United States with approximately 34,900 students locked out of the classroom. The highlights of this new bill are:

Protecting children and families

Strikes and lockouts are illegal (defined penalties for illegal work stoppage)

Protecting taxpayers

- No binding arbitration
- Tentative contract agreement made public before final vote taken
- No retroactive payments after old contract expires

Protecting teachers

Guaranteed mediation, fact-finding, non-binding arbitration, public transparency meetings and mandatory negotiating. Teachers opposed to strikes guaranteed the ability to work.

- Respecting the Constitution and collecting bargaining intent

- School and union officials must reach a mutually acceptable agreement. Neither side, nor any third party, has the right to impose a contract settlement. Increasing levels of public scrutiny are designed to encourage early settlement and avoid extreme negotiating positions.
