SUBJECT: Co-Sponsorship of Legislation: Veteran status designation on driver's licenses and identification cards.

In the near future, I plan on introducing legislation to honor veterans of the United States Armed Forces by allowing veteran status designation on Pennsylvania driver's licenses and identification cards.

A veteran may apply to the Department of Transportation to obtain a veteran designation on a driver's license or identification card by providing a United States Department of Defense discharge document, known as a DD 214, that shows a discharge status of "honorable" or "general under honorable conditions" that establishes a person's service in the armed forces of the United States.
