SUBJECT: Co-Sponsorship Memo #34: Substitute Teacher Unemployment Benefits

In the near future, I plan to reintroduce House Bill 162 from the 2009-2010 legislative session. This is a bill that I originally introduced during my time in the House of Representatives.

This bill would amend Section 402 of the Unemployment Compensation Act to include provisions for those who serve in "ancillary administrative capacit[ies] during a period between two successive academic years" to be eligible for unemployment compensation. This addition would make it possible for those who serve as frequent substitute teachers to receive unemployment compensation after their assignments have completed.
