In the near future, I will be introducing a condolence resolution honoring the life and service of Mr. Frank Gigliotti, who sadly passed away on August 7, 2011, at the age of 68.

As many of you remember, Mr. Gigliotti served as a member of the General Assembly from 1989 through 2000. He represented the 22nd District in Allegheny County, the same district that I proudly represent today. Mr. Gigliotti dedicated a major portion of his life to public service in the City of Pittsburgh, including as the Chairman of the 19th Ward Democratic Committee, Manager of the City's public safety fleet, and Superintendent of the Department of Public Works for the City of Pittsburgh.

While the circumstances of his exit from office may be the most remembered aspect of his career today, there is no doubt that Mr. Gigliotti is also remembered by many of my constituents as an unyielding and dutiful advocate of the communities he served. As such, I would like to formally acknowledge the contributions that Mr. Gigliotti made to our Commonwealth by way of his public service in the City of Pittsburgh and the General Assembly.
