In the very near future I will introduce legislation expanding Title 18 §4304 to require the reporting of suspected child abuse to law enforcement. Currently, a person in an official capacity, which prevents or interferes with the making of a report of suspected child abuse, is guilty of a 1st degree misdemeanor.

With the recent news reports relating to the scandal at Penn State in mind, this legislation is both timely and necessary. It is our responsibility to provide the children and parents of the commonwealth the best possible laws and protection. My proposal to require reporting of suspected child abuse would achieve this goal.
