Proposed Legislation - Natural Gas Tax Credits

In the near future, I intend to introduce two pieces of legislation that would provide both a tax credit for individuals that purchase a vehicle powered by natural gas fuel and a tax credit for businesses who install natural gas pumps.

My proposal amends the Tax Reform Code of 1971, allowing individuals to claim a tax credit in the amount of \$500 for the purchase of a dedicated compressed natural gas vehicle or dedicated liquefied natural gas vehicle. In addition, I am proposing a similar \$500 tax credit for businesses that install natural gas pumps.

The expanded use of natural gas as a transportation fuel offers the Commonwealth and its residents an opportunity to capitalize on locally produced, Pennsylvania natural gas – offering a clear, clean and cost effective vehicle fuel. As natural gas becomes a more domestically produced commodity and more readily available for use as a transportation fuel, it should reduce our dependence on foreign oil. Doing so will move Pennsylvanians toward energy independence.
