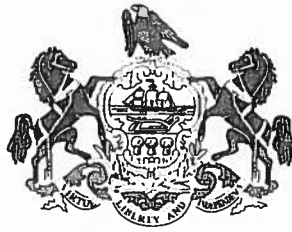

RE: Allocation of Internet taxes

DATE: February 28, 2012

In the near future, I will be introducing legislation that would utilize any sales or use tax from Internet purchases not already collected at time of purchase and allocate it to the Property Tax Relief Fund.

This category of purchases, commonly referred to as the "Amazon loophole," is already defined and the collection of sales and use tax is mandatory. This bill would not impose any new tax or change the Department of Revenue's enforcement of it.
