A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of September 2012 as "Emergency
- 2 Preparedness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year, disaster strikes communities across the
- 4 world, causing individuals to flee their homes, often with very
- 5 little advance warning; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Thousands of Americans are displaced by disasters
- 7 every year, many of them elderly and infirm; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year, the President proclaims September as
- 9 "National Emergency Preparedness Month" to stress the importance
- 10 of strengthening the security and resiliency of the nation
- 11 through systematic preparation for the full range of hazards
- 12 threatening the United States in the 21st century, including
- 13 natural disasters, cyber attacks, pandemic disease and acts of
- 14 terrorism; and
- WHEREAS, Each year, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and its
- 16 communities participate and observe September as Emergency
- 17 Preparedness Month in Pennsylvania to ensure that residents and
- 18 the townships, boroughs, cities and counties in which they live
- 19 take the steps necessary to be ready for any disaster, natural

- 1 or manmade; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Each year, in communities large and small, victims
- 3 of disasters and emergencies in Pennsylvania and across the
- 4 United States turn to neighbors, familiar and new, for help
- 5 through the American Red Cross, the Salvation Army, local fire
- 6 departments, police departments, ambulance and paramedic
- 7 services, military bases, hospitals, urban search and rescue
- 8 units, wilderness search and rescue groups, canine rescue units,
- 9 dive teams, county 911 coordinators and staff, county hazardous
- 10 material teams, local emergency management coordinators and
- 11 staff, county emergency management coordinators and staff,
- 12 Medevac agencies, State Police troops, Civil Air patrols, ham
- 13 radio operators, National Guard personnel, local fire police and
- 14 many other paid staff and volunteers with various governmental
- 15 entities, nonprofit agencies and other groups; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Disasters come in many forms, from natural disasters
- 17 like hurricanes, tornadoes or even manmade attacks like those of
- 18 eleven years ago that occurred on September 11, 2001; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency encourages
- 20 individuals to have emergency preparedness kits on hand should
- 21 disaster strike and provides information through its website,
- 22 www.ready.gov, to educate residents on how to prepare for
- 23 emergencies and disasters; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency does
- 25 its part to also assist Commonwealth residents in becoming well-
- 26 prepared for any disaster or emergency through its website,
- 27 www.readypa.org; and
- WHEREAS, Designating September as Emergency Preparedness
- 29 Month in Pennsylvania can help empower Commonwealth residents by
- 30 providing information about the risks all residents can face and

- 1 the concrete actions they can take to protect themselves, their
- 2 families, their communities, their Commonwealth and their
- 3 country; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 5 month of September 2012 as "Emergency Preparedness Month" in
- 6 Pennsylvania and extend its thanks to the many paid staff and
- 7 volunteers who serve this Commonwealth and our nation through
- 8 emergency preparedness efforts to assist and protect residents
- 9 during emergencies and disasters, natural and manmade; and be it
- 10 further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all residents
- 12 to observe September as "Emergency Preparedness Month" in
- 13 Pennsylvania and inform themselves by visiting the www.ready.gov
- 14 and www.readypa.org websites and through other resources on ways
- 15 they can become fully prepared for all emergencies.
