

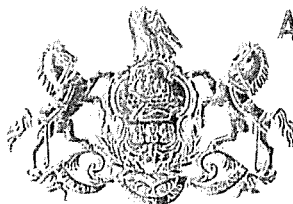

SUBJECT: Resolution Designating September 27, 2012 as "Pennsylvania First Responder Appreciation Day"
