SUBJECT: **PROPOSED RESOLUTION – DESIGNATING OCTOBER 22 -26 AS “NO PLACE FOR HATE” WEEK IN PENNSYLVANIA**

I plan to introduce a resolution designating the week of October 22, 2012 as “No Place for Hate Week” in Pennsylvania and commending the Anti-Defamation League on its 99th year and for its efforts to promote their **No Place for Hate®** program through our schools and our youth.

The **No Place for Hate®** program is an outreach effort designed to empower schools and communities to challenge racism, hatred, anti-Semitism, and bigotry in all forms. By reducing bias and increasing appreciation for diversity, **No Place for Hate®** is an innovative and powerful method for building communities of respect.

The **No Place for Hate®** program is currently working in 200 schools, 4 communities, 9 YMCAs, and 1 Police Athletic League state-wide, and is continually expanding.
