Participation in Senate Disabilities Day 2012

On Tuesday, October 16, 2012, I will host Senate Disabilities Day 2012 in recognition of National Disability Employment Awareness Month. This event will offer Senators an opportunity to experience a day-in-the-life of a disabled person by allowing them to don devices which will simulate a disability. These devices will include wheelchairs, noise-canceling headphones, vision-distorting goggles, magnifiers, augmentative communication devices and arm restraints. On the above date, in partnership with Magee Rehabilitation Hospital in Philadelphia, Temple University's Institute on Disabilities, The Arc of Philadelphia and United Cerebral Palsy of Central PA, I will have devices available for Senators, as well as staff, in the East Wing Rotunda. Not only will individuals learn how to use the various types of equipment provided for the simulation that day, but also, they will gain a better understanding of the assistive technology devices available to individuals currently living with disabilities.

Representatives from the above-mentioned organizations will be present from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the East Wing Rotunda to demonstrate how to use these devices and to sign them out to individuals for half hour to hour-long trial sessions. It is my hope this will help each one of us better understand the challenges encountered by disabled persons as we develop legislation vital to the citizens of this Commonwealth.
