Eric participated on the varsity football and wrestling teams in high school, and after graduation, went on to achieve an MBA from the University of Oxford, and Master's in Government Administration from the University of Pennsylvania. Eric also served proudly in the U.S. Military in 1996 when he joined the PA Army National Guard. In 2002, his troop was activated and he served nearly ten months on active duty, spending 6 months as a NATO peacekeeper in Bosnia. Eric succeeded in achieving many career and personal accomplishments, but was first a loving husband and father to his family. Eric married his wife, Lia, on September 15, 2001, and together the couple had two daughters, Amelia and Georgia. Eric is survived by his wife, two daughters, parents, and brother and sister, along with nieces and nephews.
