AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, " in terms and courses of study,
- providing for child exploitation awareness education.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1553.1. Child Exploitation Awareness Education.--(a)
- 13 Each school district shall incorporate an age-appropriate child
- 14 <u>exploitation awareness education program into the school</u>
- 15 <u>district's existing curriculum</u> for students in kindergarten
- 16 through eighth grade. In developing the program, the school
- 17 district shall utilize the model quidelines developed by the
- 18 Department of Education pursuant to subsection (c).
- 19 (b) Child exploitation awareness education may include, but

- 1 need not be limited to, defining child exploitation, recognizing
- 2 the types of child exploitation, creating awareness of warning
- 3 signs of child exploitation and providing students with
- 4 avoidance strategies.
- 5 (c) The Department of Education, through its Office for Safe
- 6 Schools and in consultation with at least one organization
- 7 addressing child exploitation, shall develop model quidelines
- 8 that school districts shall use in developing the education
- 9 program required under subsection (a). The department shall also
- 10 provide school districts with age-appropriate educational
- 11 <u>materials regarding child exploitation awareness</u>, which may
- 12 <u>include educational materials that are already publicly</u>
- 13 <u>available</u>.
- 14 (d) A parent or legal quardian of a student in kindergarten
- 15 through eighth grade, within a reasonable period of time after
- 16 the request is made, shall be permitted to examine the child
- 17 exploitation awareness education program instructional materials
- 18 at the school in which the student is enrolled.
- 19 (e) At the request of a parent or legal quardian, a student
- 20 <u>shall be excused from all or parts of the child exploitation</u>
- 21 awareness education program. The principal of the school in
- 22 which the student is enrolled shall notify all parents or legal
- 23 quardians of their ability to withdraw their children from
- 24 instruction in the program by returning a signed opt-out form,
- 25 after the parent or quardian has been offered the opportunity to
- 26 <u>review the instructional materials.</u>
- 27 (f) For purposes of this section, the following words and
- 28 phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection
- 29 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 30 "Child exploitation." The term includes child abduction and

- 1 sexual abuse or exploitation.
- 2 <u>"Sexual abuse or exploitation."</u> The term shall have the
- 3 meaning given to it under 23 Pa.C.S. § 6303 (relating to
- 4 <u>definitions</u>).
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
