## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in restructuring of electric utility  
3 industry, further providing for additional alternative energy  
4 sources.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 2814(c) of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 2814. Additional alternative energy sources.

11 [(c) Increase in Tier I.--The commission shall at least  
12 quarterly increase the percentage share of Tier I alternative  
13 energy sources required to be sold by an electric distribution  
14 company or electric generation supplier under section 3(b)(1) of  
15 the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act to reflect any  
16 new biomass energy or low-impact hydropower resources that  
17 qualify as a Tier I alternative energy source under this  
18 section. No new resource qualifying as biomass energy or low-

1 impact hydropower under this section shall be eligible to  
2 generate Tier I alternative energy credits until the commission  
3 has increased the percentage share of Tier I to reflect these  
4 additional resources.]

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
