## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for prior offenses.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 3806(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 3806. Prior offenses.

8 \* \* \*

9 (b) Repeat offenses within ten years.--The calculation of  
10 prior offenses for purposes of sections 1553(d.2) (relating to  
11 occupational limited license), 3803 (relating to grading) and  
12 3804 (relating to penalties) shall include any conviction,  
13 adjudication of delinquency, juvenile consent decree, acceptance  
14 of Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition or other form of  
15 preliminary disposition within the ten years before the [present  
16 violation occurred] sentencing on the present violation for any  
17 of the following:

- 1 (1) an offense under section 3802;
- 2 (2) an offense under former section 3731;
- 3 (3) an offense substantially similar to an offense under
- 4 paragraph (1) or (2) in another jurisdiction; or
- 5 (4) any combination of the offenses set forth in
- 6 paragraph (1), (2) or (3).

7 Section 2. The amendment of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3806(b) shall apply  
8 to persons sentenced on or after the effective date of this  
9 section.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
