AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), entitled 1
- "An act relating to public works contracts; providing for 2
- prevailing wages; imposing duties upon the Secretary of Labor 3

- and Industry; providing remedies, penalties and repealing existing laws, "further providing for administration. 5
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6
- hereby enacts as follows: 7
- Section 1. Section 7 of the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, 8
- 9 No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act, amended
- 10 August 9, 1963 (P.L.653, No.342), is amended to read:
- Section 7. Duty of Secretary. -- The secretary shall determine 11
- the prevailing wage rate for each county, utilizing occupational 12
- wage rate data determined by the Center for Workforce and 13
- Analysis of the department as the basis for the determination, 14
- 15 and shall, after consultation with the advisory board, determine
- the general prevailing minimum wage rate in the locality in 16
- which the public work is to be performed for each craft or 17
- classification of all workmen needed to perform public work 18
- contracts during the anticipated term thereof: Provided, 19

- 1 however, That employer and employe contributions for employe
- 2 benefits pursuant to a bona fide collective bargaining agreement
- 3 shall be considered an integral part of the wage rate for the
- 4 purpose of determining the minimum wage rate under this act.
- 5 Nothing in this act, however, shall prohibit the payment of more
- 6 than the general prevailing minimum wage rate to any workman
- 7 employed on public work. The secretary shall forthwith give
- 8 notice by mail of all determinations of general prevailing
- 9 minimum wage rates made pursuant to this section to any
- 10 representative of any craft, any employer or any representative
- 11 of any group of employers, who shall in writing request the
- 12 secretary so to do.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
