- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 3124.3. Sexual assault by sports official, volunteer or
- employee of nonprofit association. 10
- 11 (a) Sports official.--Except as provided in section 3121
- 12 (relating to rape), 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual
- 13 assault), 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual
- intercourse), 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault) and 3125 14
- (relating to aggravated indecent assault), a person who serves 15
- 16 as a sports official in a sports program of a nonprofit
- association or a for-profit association commits a felony of the 17
- 18 third degree when that person engages in sexual intercourse,

- 1 deviate sexual intercourse or indecent contact with a child
- 2 under 18 years of age who is participating in a sports program
- 3 of the nonprofit association or for-profit association.
- 4 (b) Volunteer or employee of nonprofit association. -- Except
- 5 as provided in sections 3121, 3122.1, 3123, 3124.1 and 3125, a
- 6 <u>volunteer or an employee of a nonprofit association having</u>
- 7 direct contact with a child under 18 years of age who
- 8 participates in a program or activity of the nonprofit
- 9 association commits a felony of the third degree if the
- 10 volunteer or employee engages in sexual intercourse, deviate
- 11 <u>sexual intercourse or indecent contact</u> with that child.
- 12 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 13 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Direct contact." Care, supervision, quidance or control.
- 16 "Nonprofit association." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 8332.1
- 17 (relating to manager, coach, umpire or referee and nonprofit
- 18 association negligence standard).
- 19 "Sports official." A person who supervises children
- 20 participating in a sports program of a nonprofit association or
- 21 a for-profit association, including, but not limited to, a
- 22 <u>coach</u>, <u>assistant coach</u>, <u>athletic trainer</u>, team attendant, game
- 23 manager, instructor or a person at a sports program who enforces
- 24 the rules of a sporting event sponsored by a sports program of a
- 25 nonprofit association or a for-profit association, including,
- 26 but not limited to, an umpire or referee, whether receiving
- 27 remuneration or holding the position as a volunteer.
- 28 "Sports program." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 8332.1
- 29 (relating to manager, coach, umpire or referee and nonprofit
- 30 <u>association negligence standard</u>).

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
