## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing employment of certain persons as drug and alcohol
- counselors based solely on their previous work or life
- experience; abrogating a regulation; and making inconsistent
- 4 repeals.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Drug and
- 9 Alcohol Counselor Qualification Through Work and Life Experience
- 10 Act.
- 11 Section 2. Qualifications.
- 12 Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the act of May 17,
- 13 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of
- 14 1921, Articles IX and X of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- 15 No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, the act of April 14,
- 16 1972 (P.L.221, No.63), known as the Pennsylvania Drug and
- 17 Alcohol Abuse Control Act, and the act of July 19, 1979
- 18 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act, a
- 19 person may be employed as a counselor for a drug or alcohol

- 1 treatment project based solely on the person's previous work
- 2 experience in the field of drug or alcohol treatment or the
- 3 person's life experience as a recovering addict who has
- 4 successfully completed a drug or alcohol counseling program, if
- 5 the person successfully completes an interview with a
- 6 representative of the Department of Health.
- 7 Section 3. Abrogation of regulation.
- 8 The regulation of the Department of Health at 28 Pa. Code §
- 9 704.7(b) (relating to qualifications for the position of
- 10 counselor) is abrogated.
- 11 Section 4. Repeals.
- 12 (a) Specific. -- The following acts and parts of acts are
- 13 repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this act:
- 14 Act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance
- 15 Company Law of 1921.
- Articles IX and X of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- 17 No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code.
- 18 Act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.221, No.63), known as the
- 19 Pennsylvania Drug and Alcohol Abuse Control Act.
- 20 Act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health
- 21 Care Facilities Act.
- 22 (b) General.--All other acts and parts of acts are repealed
- 23 insofar as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 24 Section 5. Effective date.
- 25 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
