## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 22, 1970 (P.L.378, No.122), entitled "An act concerning nursing homes; providing for the licensing 2 of persons charged with the general administration of such 3 homes; prescribing the powers and duties of the State Board 4 of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators; fixing fees and 5 making certain acts unlawful," further providing for functions and duties of the board. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 4(b) and (c) of the act of June 22, 1970 11 (P.L.378, No.122), known as the Nursing Home Administrators 12 License Act, are amended to read: 13 Section 4. Functions and Duties of the Board. -- \* \* \* 14 The board or any committee or member thereof, acting in 15 an official capacity, shall have the authority to issue 16 subpoenas, compel the attendance of witnesses, administer oaths 17 and take testimony concerning all matters within the 18 jurisdiction of the board. Such board shall not be bound by the 19 strict rules of evidence in the conduct of its proceedings but

any determinations made shall be founded upon sufficient legal

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- 1 evidence to sustain them. The right of appeal from decisions of
- 2 the board shall be in accordance with [the provisions of the act
- 3 of June 4, 1945 (P.L.1388), known as the "Administrative Agency
- 4 Law."] 2 Pa.C.S. Chs. 5 Subch. A (relating to practice and
- 5 procedure of Commonwealth agencies) and 7 Subch. A (relating to
- 6 judicial review of Commonwealth agency action).
- 7 (c) The board shall also have the authority to make rules
- 8 and regulations, not inconsistent with law, as may be necessary
- 9 for the proper performance of its duties, and to take such other
- 10 actions as may be necessary to enable the Commonwealth to meet
- 11 the requirements set forth in appropriate Federal law, and other
- 12 pertinent Federal authority. The rules, regulations and actions
- 13 authorized under this subsection shall address at least the
- 14 <u>following:</u>
- 15 (1) Treatment of nursing home occupants, including paying
- 16 attention to their complaints.
- 17 (2) Possession of occupants' possessions and removal of
- 18 belongings by theft or otherwise.
- 19 (3) Personal bank accounts of occupants.
- 20 (4) Accounting of occupants' retirement and Social Security
- 21 payments.
- 22 (5) Burial expenses, including prepayment requirements.
- 23 (6) Exercise of occupants, especially where needed for
- 24 health purposes.
- 25 (7) Proper attention to bed-ridden occupants to avoid
- 26 bedsores.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
