## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for simple assault
- and for aggravated assault.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Sections 2701(b)(2) and 2702(a) and (b) of Title

- 9 § 2701. Simple assault.

- 11 (b) Grading. -- Simple assault is a misdemeanor of the second
- 12 degree unless committed:

- 14 (2) against a child under 12 years of age by [an adult
- 15 21] a person 18 years of age or older, in which case it is a
- 16 misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 17 § 2702. Aggravated assault.
- 18 (a) Offense defined.--A person is guilty of aggravated

- 2 (1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another, 3 or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly 4 under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the 5 value of human life;
  - (2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c) or to an employee of an agency, company or other entity engaged in public transportation, while in the performance of duty;
    - (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), in the performance of duty;
    - (4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon:
    - (5) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board member or other employee, including a student employee, of any elementary or secondary publicly-funded educational institution, any elementary or secondary private school licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his or her employment or because of his or her employment relationship to the school;
    - (6) attempts by physical menace to put any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), while in the performance of duty, in fear of imminent serious bodily injury; [or]

- 1 (7) uses tear or noxious gas as defined in section
- 2 2708(b) (relating to use of tear or noxious gas in labor
- disputes) or uses an electric or electronic incapacitation
- device against any officer, employee or other person
- 5 enumerated in subsection (c) while acting in the scope of his
- 6 employment[.];
- 7 (8) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 8 recklessly causes bodily injury to a child under four years
- 9 of age; or
- 10 (9) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 11 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to a child under 12
- 12 years of age.
- 13 (b) Grading. -- Aggravated assault under subsection (a) (1)
- 14 [and (2)], (2) and (9) is a felony of the first degree.
- 15 Aggravated assault under subsection (a)(3), (4), (5), (6) [and
- 16 (7)], (7) and (8) is a felony of the second degree.

- 18 Section 2. The amendment of 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 2701(b)(2) and
- 19 2702(a) and (b) shall apply to offenses committed on or after
- 20 the effective date of this section.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
