AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Family Caregiver Support Advisory Board within
- the Department of Public Welfare; and providing for its
- 3 powers and duties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Family
- 8 Caregiver Support Advisory Board Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Board." The Family Caregiver Support Advisory Board.
- 14 "Department." The Department of Public Welfare of the
- 15 Commonwealth.
- 16 Section 3. Family Caregiver Support Advisory Board.
- 17 (a) Establishment.--The Department of Public Welfare shall
- 18 establish a Family Caregiver Support Advisory Board within the

- 1 department.
- 2 (b) Membership.--The board shall consist of nine volunteer
- 3 members selected by the department from eligible applicants. The
- 4 department shall issue a notice to be published in the
- 5 Pennsylvania Bulletin and shall post on its publicly accessible
- 6 Internet website the procedure for individuals to apply as a
- 7 volunteer to be selected for appointment to the board.
- 8 (c) Term of office.--
- 9 (1) A member of the board shall serve for a four-year 10 term, subject to removal by the department. The first members
- of the board shall serve as follows:
- 12 (i) Three members shall have a term ending January
- 13 1, 2014.
- 14 (ii) Three members shall have a term ending January
- 15 1, 2015.
- 16 (iii) Three members shall have a term ending January
- 17 1, 2016.
- 18 (2) Before the expiration of the term of a member, the
- department shall appoint a successor whose term shall begin
- on the following July 1.
- 21 (3) A member shall be eligible for reappointment.
- 22 (4) If there is a vacancy of any member's office, the
- 23 department shall make an appointment to become immediately
- 24 effective for the unexpired term.
- 25 (5) A member of the board shall receive no reimbursement
- for any expenses incurred in the performance of official
- 27 duties of the board.
- 28 (d) Eligibility. -- In order to qualify for membership on the
- 29 board, the individual must be a resident of this Commonwealth
- 30 and be well-informed about the needs of family caregivers.

- 1 (e) Officers.--The board shall select one of its members as
- 2 chairperson and another as vice chairperson for the terms and
- 3 with the duties and powers as necessary for the performance of
- 4 the functions as the board determines.
- 5 (f) Quorum.--A majority of the members of the board shall
- 6 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- 7 (g) Meetings.--The board shall meet at least once every
- 8 three months as determined by the board. The board may also meet
- 9 at other times as specified by the call of the chairperson or of
- 10 a majority of the members of the board.
- 11 Section 4. Powers and duties.
- 12 The board shall advise the department on the needs of family
- 13 caregivers in programs administered by the department.
- 14 Section 5. Regulations.
- 15 The board shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to
- 16 administer this act.
- 17 Section 20. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
