- 12 Section 1317.3. Uniforms and Prohibited Attire.--[The] (a)
- 13 Subject to the provisions in subsection (b), the board of

- 15 and may require pupils to wear standard dress or uniforms. Dress
- 16 policies may be applicable throughout the school entity or may
- 17 be applicable to one or more school buildings within the school

- 19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), the

- 2 class shall adopt a policy to prohibit pupils from wearing
- 3 hooded shirts, hats and any other attire that conceal, obscure
- 4 or disquise the face of the person wearing the attire.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
