AN ACT

- 1 Providing for notice of motor vehicle event data recorders and
- for information retrieval; imposing penalties; and providing
- 3 for evidentiary rules.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle
- 8 Event Data Recorder Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Authorized person." A licensed new motor vehicle dealer or
- 14 a licensed automotive technician.
- 15 "Lease." A lease agreement between a lessor and lessee for a
- 16 term of at least 12 months.
- "Motor vehicle event data recorder." A device installed in a
- 18 motor vehicle by the manufacturer of the vehicle for the purpose

- 1 of retrieving data about the operation of the motor vehicle,
- 2 including data relating to speed, direction, location,
- 3 operational functioning and use of safety devices in the motor
- 4 vehicle.
- 5 "New motor vehicle." The term includes only a new motor
- 6 vehicle that is purchased or leased for personal use.
- 7 Section 3. New vehicle notice.
- 8 (a) Requirement.--The manufacturer of a new motor vehicle
- 9 sold or leased in this Commonwealth shall disclose the following
- 10 in the owner's manual of the vehicle:
- 11 (1) Whether the new motor vehicle is equipped with a
- 12 motor vehicle event data recorder.
- 13 (2) If the new motor vehicle is equipped with a motor
- vehicle event data recorder:
- (i) a description of the data which can be recorded;
- 16 and
- 17 (ii) notice that data downloaded or otherwise
- 18 retrieved by an event data recorder or similar device can
- be used as evidence in legal proceedings.
- 20 (b) Penalty.--A violation of this act shall constitute a
- 21 violation of the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387),
- 22 known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.
- 23 Section 4. Information retrieval.
- 24 (a) General rule. -- Only authorized persons may download or
- 25 otherwise retrieve a motor vehicle event data recorder and no
- 26 information downloaded or otherwise retrieved by authorized
- 27 persons may be released or shared with any individual except
- 28 under one of the following circumstances:
- 29 (1) The owner of the motor vehicle consents to the
- downloading, retrieval, use, release or sharing.

- 1 (2) A court order, including after an accident involving 2 the motor vehicle, is lawfully issued.
- 3 (3) The motor vehicle event data recorder or data is 4 retrieved or used for research purposes related to improving 5 vehicle safety, provided the identity of the registered owner
- 7 (4) The motor vehicle event data recorder or data is 8 retrieved, used, released or shared for the purpose of 9 diagnosing, servicing or repairing the vehicle.
- 10 (5) The National Transportation Safety Board makes a 11 request as part of an official accident investigation.
- 12 (b) Exemption.--Subsection (a) does not apply to
- 13 subscription services.

- 14 (c) Grading.--An individual who violates subsection (a)
- 15 commits a summary offense.
- 16 Section 5. Evidence.
- 17 (a) General rule. -- Data from a motor vehicle event data
- 18 recorder that is downloaded, retrieved, used, released or shared
- 19 in violation of this act is inadmissible in evidence in any
- 20 civil, criminal or administrative action.

or driver is not disclosed.

- 21 (b) Use of evidence. -- Data from a motor vehicle event data
- 22 recorder that is downloaded, retrieved, used, released or shared
- 23 in accordance with this act shall be insufficient to support an
- 24 adjudication of the cause of a motor vehicle accident unless it
- 25 is corroborated by other evidence.
- 26 (c) Applicability. -- This section shall apply to an action
- 27 initiated on or after the effective date of this section.
- 28 Section 6. Subscription services.
- 29 If a motor vehicle event recorder is installed as part of a
- 30 subscription service, the subscription service agreement shall

- 1 disclose that the device may record or transmit information as
- 2 described in section 3.
- 3 Section 7. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
