Investigation by police officers. 8 * * * 9 (b) Authority of police officer .--10 (1) Whenever a police officer is engaged in a systematic 11 program of checking vehicles or drivers or has reasonable 12 suspicion that a violation of this title is occurring or has 13 occurred, he may stop a vehicle, upon request or signal, for 14 the purpose of checking the vehicle's registration, proof of 15 financial responsibility, vehicle identification number or 16 engine number or the driver's license, or to secure such 17 other information as the officer may reasonably believe to be 18

1 necessary to enforce the provisions of this title. 2 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1), no police officer who stops a vehicle in accordance with 3 paragraph (1) may use a data extraction device to secure 4 5 information from an electronic device in the possession of the driver or passenger in the vehicle. 6 7 (3) For purposes of this subsection, "data extraction 8 device" means a tool used to extract data stored in a 9 telecommunications device, including, but not limited to, the 10 following data: call history, text messages, contacts, images, videos, geotags, voicemails, voice recordings, source 11 messaging service (SMS) messages, multimedia messaging 12 13 service (MMS) messages or subscriber identification module 14 (SIM) data. * * * 15 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
