AN ACT

- 1 Providing for bisphenol A-free food and beverage container 2 products.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Bisphenol A-
- 7 free Food and Beverage Container Products Act.
- 8 Section 2. Bisphenol A-free and food and beverage containers.
- 9 No person or entity may manufacture, sell or distribute any
- 10 food or beverage container that contains bisphenol A at a level
- 11 above 0.1 parts per billion (ppb) if the food or beverage
- 12 container serves as a package, parcel or other vessel intended
- 13 for use in storing, heating or serving liquids or solids
- 14 intended for consumption by the general population.
- 15 (1) Manufacturers shall use the least toxic alternative
- when replacing bisphenol A in containers in accordance with
- 17 this section.

- 1 (2) Manufacturers may not replace bisphenol A pursuant
- 2 to this section with carcinogens rated by the Environmental
- 3 Protection Agency as A, B or C carcinogens or substances
- 4 listed as known or likely carcinogens, known to be human
- 5 carcinogens, likely to be human carcinogens or suggestive of
- 6 being human carcinogens, as described in the "List of
- 7 Chemicals Evaluated for Carcinogenic Potential."
- 8 (3) Manufacturers may not replace bisphenol A pursuant
- 9 to this section with reproductive toxicants that cause birth
- 10 defects, reproductive harm or developmental harm, as
- identified by the Environmental Protection Agency.
- 12 Section 3. Violation of Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer
- 13 Protection Law.
- 14 A violation of section 2 constitutes unfair methods of
- 15 competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices within the
- 16 meaning of section 2(4) of the act of December 17, 1968
- 17 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and
- 18 Consumer Protection Law, and shall be subject to the enforcement
- 19 provisions, civil penalties and private rights of action
- 20 contained in that act.
- 21 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
