

AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for special plates for Pearl
3 Harbor survivors, for special plates for veterans of Korean
4 War, for special plates for recipients of Korean Defense
5 Service Medal, for special plates for veterans of Persian
6 Gulf War, for special plates for recipients of Expeditionary
7 Forces Medal, for special plates for World War II veterans,
8 for special plates for veterans of Vietnam Conflict, for
9 special motorcycle plates for veterans, for Operation Iraqi
10 Freedom veterans plate, for Operation Enduring Freedom
11 veterans plate, for special plates for veterans and for Gold
12 Star Family plate.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Sections 1348, 1350, 1350.1, 1351, 1356, 1357,
16 1360, 1361, 1362 and 1363 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
17 Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

18 § 1348. Special plates for Pearl Harbor survivors.

19 Upon application of any person who is a survivor of Pearl
20 Harbor, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50 which shall be in
21 addition to the annual registration fee and by such
22 documentation as the department shall require, the department
23 shall issue to such person a special registration plate

1 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
2 is a survivor of Pearl Harbor. The special registration plate
3 may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered
4 gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.

5 § 1350. Special plates for veterans of Korean War.

6 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the Korean
7 War, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50, which shall be in
8 addition to the annual registration fee, and by such
9 documentation as the department shall require, the department
10 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
11 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
12 is a veteran of the Korean War. The special registration plate
13 may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered
14 gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.

15 § 1350.1. Special plates for recipients of Korean Defense
16 Service Medal.

17 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the
18 Korean Defense Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of [\$20]
19 \$7.50 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee
20 and by such documentation as the department shall require, the
21 department shall issue to the person a special registration
22 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a
23 person who is a recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal.
24 The department shall design and produce the special registration
25 plate. The special registration plate may be used only on a
26 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
27 more than 10,000 pounds.

28 § 1351. Special plates for veterans of Persian Gulf War.

29 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
30 Persian Gulf War, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50, which

1 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, and by such
2 documentation as the department shall require, the department
3 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
4 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
5 is a veteran of the Persian Gulf War. The special registration
6 plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a
7 registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.

8 § 1356. Special plates for recipients of Expeditionary Forces
9 Medal.

10 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the
11 Expeditionary Forces Medal, accompanied by a fee of [~~\$20~~] \$7.50
12 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by
13 such documentation as the department shall require, the
14 department shall issue to such person a special registration
15 plate designating the vehicle so registered as belonging to a
16 person who is a recipient of the Expeditionary Forces Medal. The
17 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car
18 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000
19 pounds.

20 § 1357. Special plates for World War II veterans.

21 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of World War
22 II, accompanied by a fee of [~~\$20~~] \$7.50 which shall be in
23 addition to the annual registration fee and by such
24 documentation as the department shall require, the department
25 shall issue to such person a special registration plate carrying
26 the symbol of a ruptured duck designating the vehicle so
27 registered as belonging to a person who is a veteran of World
28 War II. The special registration plate may be used only on a
29 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
30 more than 10,000 pounds.

1 § 1360. Special plates for veterans of Vietnam Conflict.

2 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
3 Vietnam Conflict as that term is defined for the awarding of the
4 Vietnam Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50 in
5 addition to the annual registration fee and by such
6 documentation as the department shall require, the department
7 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
8 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
9 is a veteran of the Vietnam Conflict. The special registration
10 plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a
11 registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.

12 § 1361. Special motorcycle plates for veterans.

13 Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged
14 veteran of the armed forces of the United States, or a reserve
15 component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301
16 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50
17 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by
18 such documentation as the department shall require, the
19 department shall issue to the person a special registration
20 plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a
21 veteran. The special registration plate may be used only on a
22 motorcycle.

23 § 1362. Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans plate.

24 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
25 liberation or occupation of Iraq, accompanied by a fee of [\$20]
26 \$7.50 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee
27 and by documentation as the department shall require, the
28 department shall issue to the person a special registration
29 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a
30 person who is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The special

1 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
2 with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.
3 § 1363. Operation Enduring Freedom veterans plate.

4 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the
5 liberation or occupation of Afghanistan, accompanied by a fee of
6 [\$20] \$7.50 which shall be in addition to the annual
7 registration fee and by documentation as the department shall
8 require, the department shall issue to the person a special
9 registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as
10 belonging to a person who is a veteran of Operation Enduring
11 Freedom. The special registration plate may be used only on a
12 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
13 more than 10,000 pounds.

14 Section 2. Section 1364(a) of Title 75, amended October 24,
15 2012 (P.L.1602, No.194), is amended to read:

16 § 1364. Special plates for veterans.

17 (a) Honorably discharged veterans.--Upon application of any
18 person who is an honorably discharged veteran of the armed
19 forces of the United States or a reserve component of the armed
20 forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to
21 definitions), accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50 which shall be
22 in addition to the annual registration fee and by such
23 documentation as the department shall require, the department
24 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
25 designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a
26 veteran of the armed forces of the United States. The special
27 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
28 with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.

30 Section 3. Section 1365 of Title 75 is amended to read:

1 § 1365. Gold Star Family plate.

2 (a) General rule.--Upon application of a family member of a
3 person who was killed while serving on active duty in the
4 military, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$7.50 which shall be in
5 addition to the annual registration fee and by such
6 documentation as the department shall require, the department
7 shall issue to the family member a special registration plate
8 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a family
9 member of a person who was killed while serving on active duty
10 in the military. The department shall design and produce the
11 special registration plate carrying the Service Flag Gold Star
12 rimmed with blue which represents sacrifice to the cause of
13 liberty and freedom. The words "Gold Star Family" shall be
14 clearly displayed along the bottom of the plate. The special
15 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
16 with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.
