- WHEREAS, At Harrisburg's SciTech Campus, Ms. Ridgeway is
- 8 involved in the school's student council, is a member of the
- 9 school's cheerleading squad and serves on the Harrisburg Rotary
- 10 Youth Community Development Team; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Realizing that national and international problems
- 12 and crises have an impact locally, Ms. Ridgeway helped to
- 13 organize a fundraising effort to help all those affected by the
- 14 2010 earthquake in Haiti; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Ridgeway is also a member of national
- 16 organizations such as the Southern Poverty Law Center and the
- 17 N.A.A.C.P's Schomberg Center for Research; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Ms. Ridgeway's past honors and awards include

- 20 Pennsylvania Good Citizen Award; and
